Learn together:

Hebrews 5:13 NLT ... someone who lives on milk is still an infant and doesn't know how to do what is right.

Read together:

When you were a baby, you acted like one. You couldn't even take care of yourself! But now you're older, and you're more mature. How have you changed?

You'll need:

- Paper
- Something to write with
- Tape (optional)
- Current pictures • Baby pictures (optional) (optional)

What to do:

- 1. On one side of the paper, draw yourself as a baby or tape a picture of yourself as a baby.
- 2. Draw or write the ways other people had to take care of you and the immature things you used to do when you were a baby.
- 3. On the other side of the paper, draw what you look like now or tape a picture of yourself.
- 4. Draw or write the mature things you do now and the ways you take care of yourself.
