### **NOTICE TO OUR FARRINGDON FAMILY**

At this time, provincial restrictions regarding gatherings outside of our households remain in place. New reopening phases began June 14, but numbers for gatherings will continue to be very limited. Due to this announcement, we will unfortunately need to remain closed for in person worship at Farringdon until restrictions are eased.

We will continue providing our weekly worship service online and will also continue to send it out to all members via mail or email. If you have any announcements you wish to have included in the weekly mailout please let Margot know.

Please continue to reach out to others in our church family as we remain apart, and contact your elder, myself or Rev. Mike if you know of anyone in need of assistance or outreach during this time.

We will continue to observe provincial recommendations and guidelines and look forward to the day when we may reopen our doors for worship. The Farringdon Joint Board has tentatively approved our reopening at Farringdon for in-person worship for Sunday, September 19. At that point, the province should be in the final reopening phase which will allow us to meet in person with fewer restrictions. The final reopening phase is scheduled to begin mid-August, but with many on vacation we felt September would be an optimal time for us to return, especially as it is projected most will be fully vaccinated by September.

This date will coincide with Rally Sunday, which will make the day a wonderful celebration. More details will be forthcoming as our reopening date approaches.

Bible Reading: Luke 10:25-37

25 **On one occasion an expert in the law stood up to test Jesus. "Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"**

26 **"What is written in the Law?" he replied. "How do you read it?"**

27 **He answered, "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind' and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'**

- 28 **“You have answered correctly,” Jesus replied. “Do this and you will live.”**
- 29 **But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, “And who is my neighbor?”**
- 30 **In reply Jesus said: “A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead.**
- 31 **A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side.**
- 32 **So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side.**
- 33 **But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him.**
- 34 **He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him.**
- 35 **The next day he took out two denarii[c] and gave them to the innkeeper. ‘Look after him,’ he said, ‘and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.’**
- 36 **“Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?”**
- 37 **The expert in the law replied, “The one who had mercy on him.” Jesus told him, “Go and do likewise.”**
