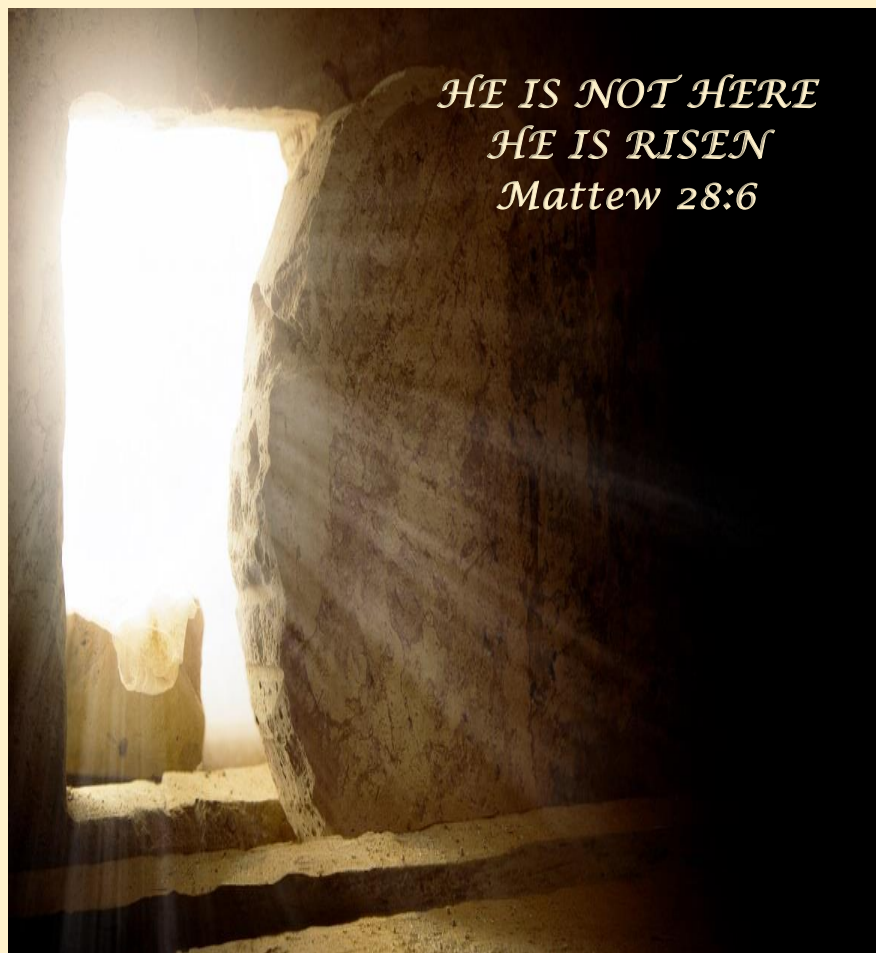

WELCOME TO FARRINGDON CHURCH!

Thank you for joining our worship service.

Everything you need for the service is in this bulletin.

Hymn books and Bibles are in the pew racks.

Hand sanitizers are provided throughout the building. Please, use them.

Wearing a mask is now optional, as per provincial regulations.

Washrooms are downstairs: one is a barrier-free washroom below the Narthex, two more are in the Christian Education wing, accessible via the elevator or stairs. Just ask for directions.

Children are a special part of our church, so we include a Children's time in the worship service. After this, children go with Katelyn to the conference room for Sunday School.

Sunday School is available to children ages 5-12 . There is no nursery care at this time due to health precautions. If your child wishes to remain with you in the service, that is fine. All parents must pick up their children from Sunday School.

The **offering** is a member responsibility. So, if you are visiting, simply, be our guest. All who include their name and mailing information on an offering envelope will receive a tax-deductible receipt. Offering plates are at the front and rear exits.

Corporate communion is held on the second Sunday of each month.

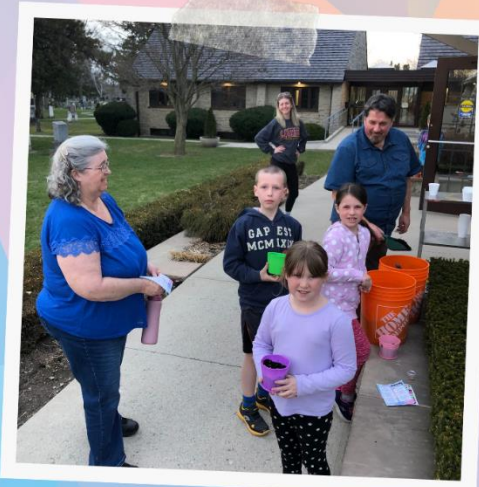
